REGISTRATION / GENERAL AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, (must be of legal age [18 years or older] to sign) agree that the Host Club has the right to refuse my entry for causes that the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient.

I agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owners of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, or otherwise be caused by or alleged to be caused by negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any person, or any other cause or causes.

I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting thereof, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

the same rules and regulations as all regular classes except those stated in Chapter 3 of the AAC Rules and Regulations 2005, page 3-4.

Starters Standard Agility Class: Shall be open to dogs not having earned the ADC/SADC/VADC Title. This class will be scored under the provisions of Chapter 3 of the AAC Rules and Regulations. Dogs completing the course with three (3) clear rounds under at least 2 different judges shall be awarded the ADC/SADC/VADC title.

Advanced Standard Agility Class: Shall be open to dogs having earned the ADC/SADC/VADC title but not having earned the AADC/SAADC/VAADC Title. The class will be scored under the provisions of Chapter 3 of the AAC Rules and Regulations. Dogs achieving three (3) clear rounds under at least two different judges shall be awarded the AADC/SAADC/VAADC title.

Masters Standard Agility Class: Shall be open to dogs having earned the AADC/SAADC/VAADC title but not having earned the MADC/SMADC/VMADC title. Dogs achieving three (3) clear rounds under 2 different judges in this class shall be awarded the MADC/SMADC/VMADC title.

Starters Jumpers/Gamblers/Snooker/Team Class: Shall be open to all dogs that have not received a qualifying score in that class.

Advanced Jumpers/Gamblers/Snooker/ Team Class: Shall be open to all dogs that have received a qualifying score in that Starters "Game" Class but have not received two (2) qualifying scores under two different judges in this class or who have not received one qualifying score in this class.

Masters Jumpers/Gamblers/Snooker/Team Class: Shall be open to all dogs that have received two (2) qualifying scores under two different judges in the Advanced/Special/Veteran "Game" Class.

Any dog that earns a title must move up to the next level at the next trial it attends (if the level is offered). If a level is not offered at a given trial, a dog may compete for placement, prizes, etc., one level down (not FEO). Dogs that achieve their Masters or Masters Games titles shall be permitted to continue competing in these classes and shall be eligible for placement, prizes, etc.

This event is open to all dogs over eighteen (18) months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

DESCRIPTION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

Junior Handlers Program: The Junior Handler Program is open to children up to and including seventeen (17) years of age. Juniors and dogs may compete without regard to their accomplishments in any other agility class. The junior may handle a different dog from one trial to the next, but is permitted to run only one dog per junior handler class. The dog may or may not be owned by the handler. Any dog entered in a junior handler class may compete in other regular classes at the same AAC trial provided it does so with a different handler.

A junior may not compete in regular classes (including games) at the same AAC trial, but may compete in regular (non-junior) classes at a different AAC trial. It is the handler's option whether the dog runs at its regulation height or at one height lower for the junior handler class. Specials and Veterans may drop one jump height from their normal Special or Veteran jump height.

Note that certificates of achievement in the junior handler program are given to the handler and not the dog(s).

Starters Junior Class: Open to handlers who have not earned a Junior Handler Award of Merit – Starters Level. A handler must achieve three (3) clear rounds (0 course and time faults) in this class pursuant to the rules and regulations. Starters junior handlers classes will use the same course as is used for Starters Standard dogs and will be judged by the same judge.

Advanced Junior Class: Open to handlers who have not earned a Junior Handler Award of Merit – Advanced Level. A handler must achieve three (3) clear rounds (0 course and time faults) in this class pursuant to the rules and regulations. Advanced junior handlers will use the same course as Advanced Standard dogs, and be judged by the same judge.

Masters Junior Class: Open to handlers who have not earned a Junior Handler Award of Merit – Masters Level. A handler must achieve three (3) clear rounds (0 course and time faults) in this class pursuant to the rules and regulations. Masters junior handlers will use the same course as is used for Masters Standard dogs and will be judged by the same judge.

Veteran and Special Agility Classes: **Veteran Agility Classes** shall be for dogs seven (7) years of age or older, in the case of dogs currently competing in any Standard Agility Class. This class shall also be for dogs five (5) years of age or older who have been competing in the Special Agility Classes for a minimum of one (1) calendar year. **Special Agility Classes** shall be open to all dogs. A dog may no longer compete in regular classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Veteran Agility Classes or Special Agility Classes. All dogs entered in Veterans classes must jump one height lower, and may move down one additional height at the handler's discretion. Dogs moving into the Veteran or Special Agility Classes move laterally, that is bringing any legs they have earned in the regular classes with them. These classes shall be subject to

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event of a dog and/or handler being dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be made for medical reasons (dog or handler) or for bitches in season, with certification from a vet. No bitches in season will be accommodated on the site.

Handlers and dogs should be familiar with AAC equipment. Training will not be allowed. There shall be no food or toys used in the ring at any time. Collars can be worn during the warm-up period **only**.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES: Any handler who is found to abuse a dog in any way at any AAC sanctioned event will be required to leave the site. In an incident of abuse or dog aggression, toward another dog or person, occurs, the incident **MUST** be reported to the Judge or Trial officials. Anyone witnessing an act of abuse or aggression may make a complaint to the host club or AAC.

AGILITY OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Ribbons for 1st through 4th, in each height class. AAC Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to handlers completing qualifying rounds. For Junior Handlers, ribbons of Gold (1st), Silver (2nd) and Bronze (3rd). AAC Qualifying ribbons awarded for all qualifying rounds.

VOLUNTEERS: all volunteers will be entered in a draw for prizes.
